FINAL Statement from Superintendent Dr. Deena Bishop on Insurance and Strategies 360

The Anchorage School District, like other organizations, has insurance. ASD has a policy, through Allied World Assurance Company that includes a separate service for crisis response endorsement which covers assistance for affected individuals throughout a crisis, including crisis communication services.

It is imperative that ASD is prudent and responsible with the taxpayer funds that support the district. Strategies 360's work to date and any ongoing crisis communication work with the district around the incidents at Dimond High School and Ptarmigan Elementary School will be paid for under the crisis response endorsement.

At the request of our provider, detailed invoices for services provided will be approved by ASD and billed directly from Strategies 360 to the insurance company.
